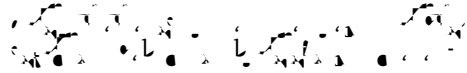


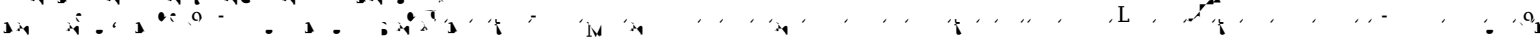
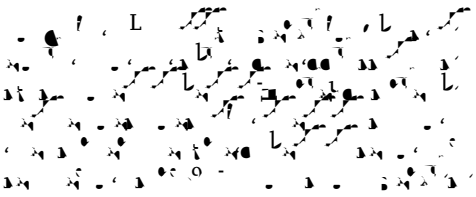
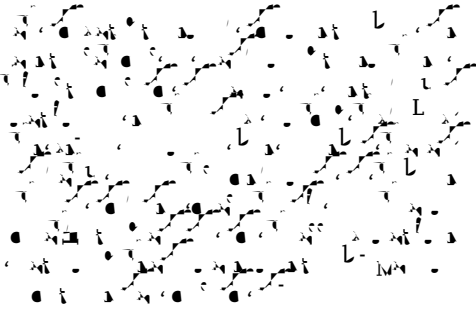
## About the Director

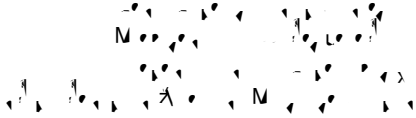

## Professors David Elder and Lowell Schechter Retire

**DAVID A. ELDER**, a professor of law at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, and **LOWELL SCHECHTER**, a professor of law at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, have retired.

The College of Law has established the NKU Chase Children's Law Clinic, a partnership between the law school and the Children's Law Center in Covington, Kentucky. The Clinic is the brainchild of alumna Kim Brooks Tandy '89, Director of the Children's Law Center, and Professor Emeritus Lowell Schechter. The Clinic will be housed in the Lowell Schechter Student Learning Center, a newly-renovated and fully-equipped 3000+ foot clinic space on the third floor of the Children's Law Center.

Professor Amy Halbrook will direct the Clinic. Professor Halbrook joins the law school after completing clinical teaching fellowships in the Children and Family Justice Center at Northwestern University School of Law and the Loyola University Chicago Civitas Child Law Clinic. "I hope to empower Chase students to become compassionate, dedicated lawyers for children and youth," says Halbrook.

Clinic students will receive specialized instruction and training in child and family law and advocacy, with a focus on abuse and neglect, family law, juvenile justice, education, professional responsibility and advocacy techniques. Under close supervision, students will then provide high-quality legal representation to child clients in child protection, high-conflict custody, school, and other matters. In addition to their litigation duties, students may participate in research, policy development and community education related to children's issues.

"The intensive level of instruction and experiential learning these students will receive is a welcome addition to our student opportunities here," Kim Tandy noted. "We're thrilled that Amy will be joining our team and

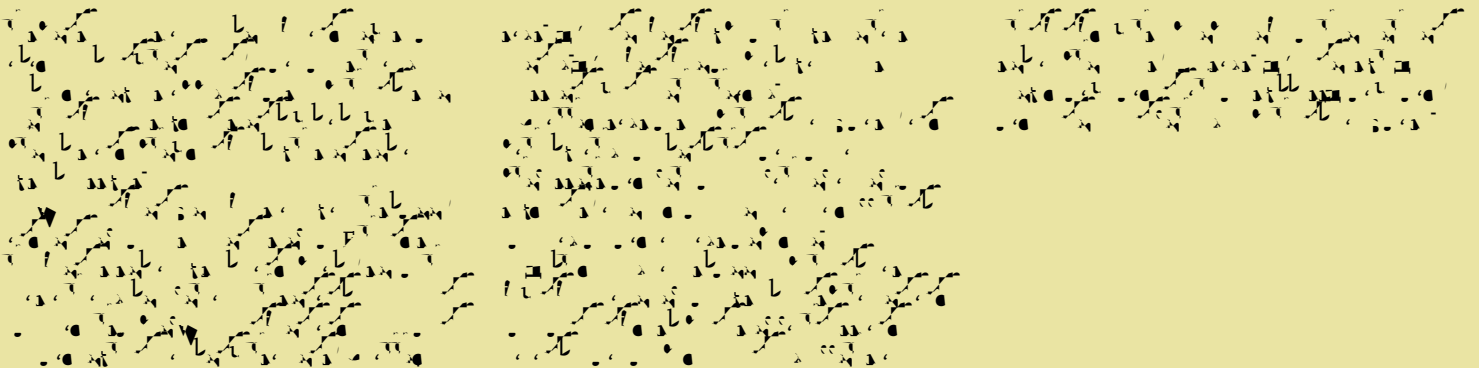

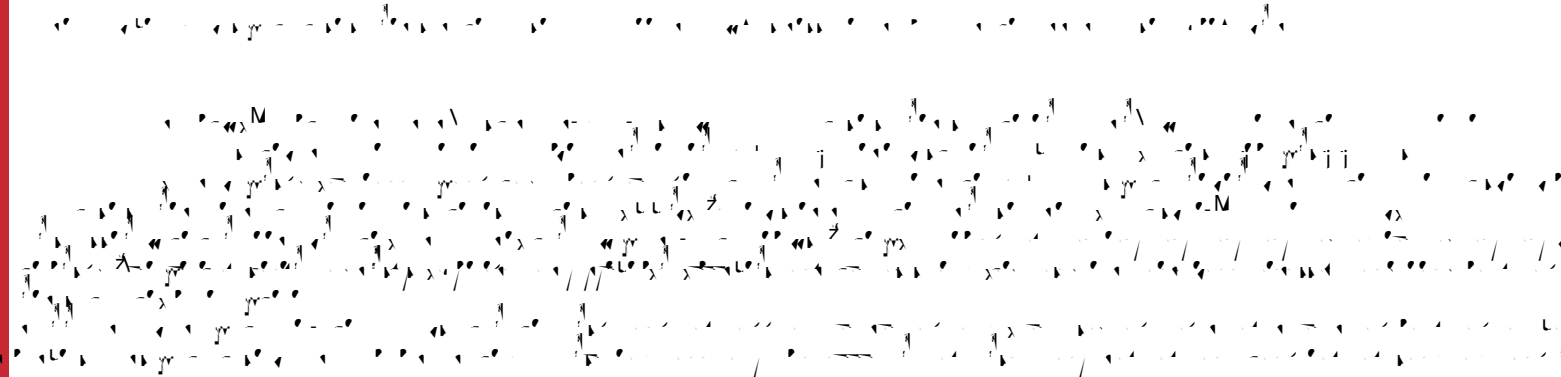
